



## PAPER STAR

### WHAT YOU NEED:

the help of an adult  
a pair of scissors

6 squares of coloured paper  
sticky tape

### WHAT YOU DO:

Fold the square into a triangle, then fold the triangle into a smaller triangle.

Use the scissors to make three cuts from the centre fold of the small triangle to the edge made up of two folds of paper. Then open the paper out flat.

Take the two inner strips of paper, in the square, and bring them up together so one overlaps the other. Tape them in place.

Turn the paper over and do the same with the next two strips. Turn the paper again and repeat; turning one more time to bring the last two strips of paper up and tape them in place.

Repeat this process for all 6 pieces of paper.

Fold 12 pieces of tape to make them "double sided" and join stick a piece on the outer sides of each folded square. Then bring the two outer twists together and tape them into place.

Tape the inner points of each twist together to hold them in place.
